**APPROVE PURCHASE OF USED TOYOTA FORKLIFT**

**A RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, for the purpose of approving the purchase and waiving the competitive bidding requirements due to special market conditions for the purchase of one used 2008 Toyota 8FGU25 forklift from Mid Columbia Forklift, Inc. Sales.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District met in regular session on January 19, 2010 with a quorum present, and,

**WHEREAS**, RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) permits the Board of Directors to waive the competitive bid requirement for the purchase of used equipment based on special market conditions, and,

**WHEREAS**, Mid Columbia Forklift is a local vendor providing this specific equipment for sale and providing repair services and parts locally, and

**WHEREAS**, the selling prices for this model of Toyota forklift were extensively researched for identical models with similar run time hours, and the forklift selected provides KID with the best price for a used machine in this condition, and


**WHEREAS**, the service life of this forklift at KID is estimated to be a minimum of fifteen years,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT, BENTON COUNTY, WASHINGTON**, that the purchase of one used 2008 Toyota 8FGU25 forklift from Mid Columbia Forklift, Inc. Sales is approved, and that the competitive bidding requirements are waived due to special market conditions for this purchase, and that 2010 capital equipment budget monies shall be used during January 2010 to finalize the purchase of this piece of equipment, and that the total costs for this purchase shall not exceed \$21,000.
