SET PUBLIC HEARING DATE FOR PROPOSED BRETZ ROAD IRRIGATION SYSTEM LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, for the purpose of setting a public hearing for the formation of the **BRETZ ROAD IRRIGATION SYSTEM** Local Improvement District (LID), consisting of Lots 1 and 2 of Short Plat 1240 lying in Section 17, Township 9 North, Range 28 East W.M. and All lots of Short Plats 1401, 1604, 2210, 2252, 2271, and 2272 and Lot 3 Short Plat 2650 lying Section 20 Township 9 North, Range 28 East W.M. shown generally on attached map, Exhibit A, in accordance to RCW 87.03.480.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District met in regular session on August 17, 2010 with a quorum present, and,

WHEREAS, The District has completed the feasibility study, and found that the proposed LID is feasible, and,


WHEREAS, the Board is required to fix a time and place for the hearing and to cause notice of that hearing to be published and mailed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT BENTON COUNTY WASHINGTON as follows:

SET THE TIME AND DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING: The public hearing on the formation of the LID for the making of certain improvements as described in the petition, attached hereto as Exhibit B, and incorporated herein by this reference, with the addition of a late comers fee and the option for the six properties not wanting to be in the LID to opt out, will be held before the Board on Tuesday, September 21, 2010 at 9:00 a.m., local time, at the Kennewick Irrigation District, 12 W. Kennewick Avenue, Kennewick, Washington. This will be published once a week for two consecutive weeks and direct notice shall be mailed to the proposed LID landowners in accordance to RCW 87.03.485.

RESOLUTION 2010-18 IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, at a regular open public meeting thereof this 7th day of September 2010.

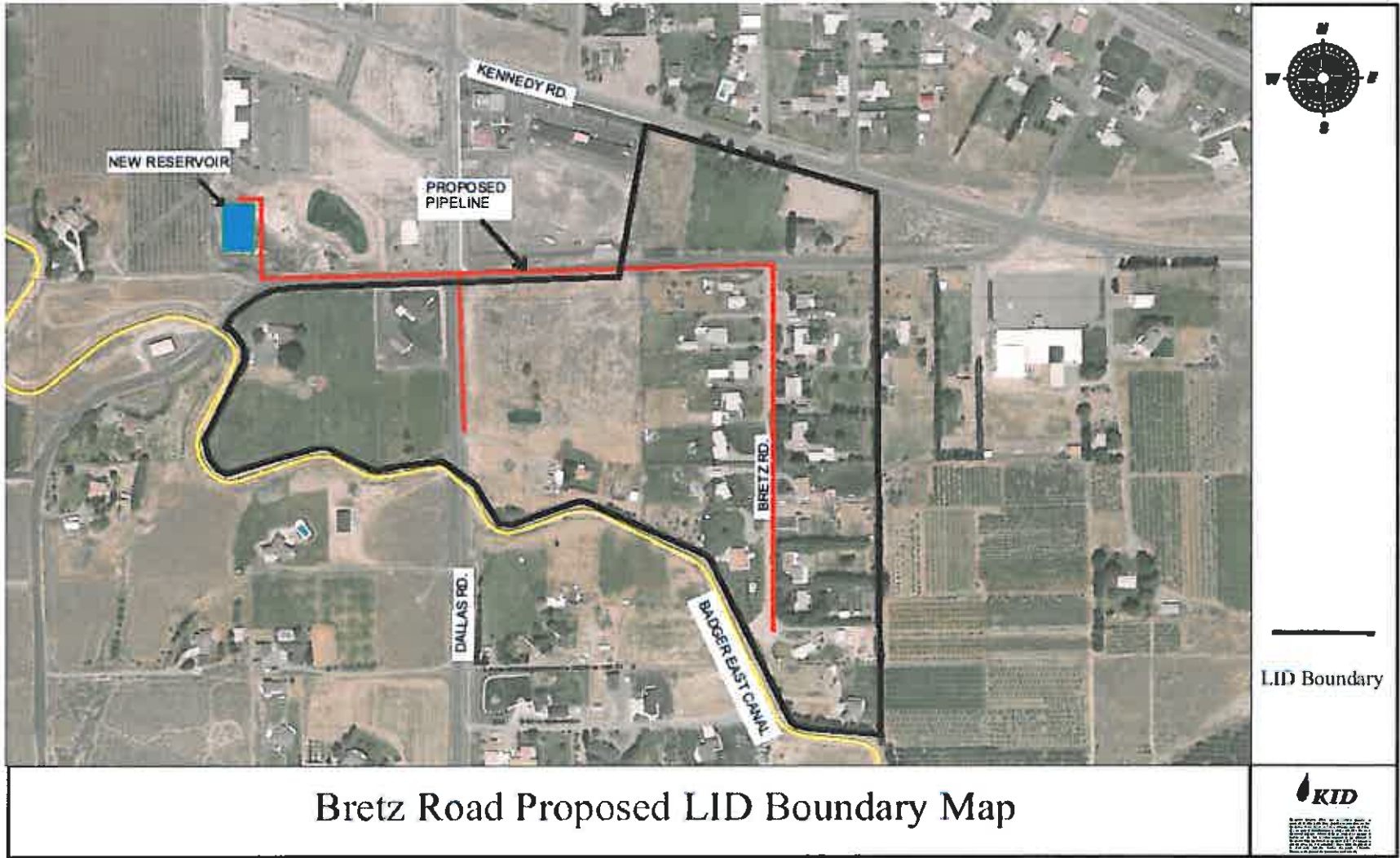

Note: A preliminary study of your area has been conducted and the findings demonstrate sufficient interest to initiate a petition for pressurized irrigation LID. Signing this petition does not commit your property to an LID and LID assessments. Signing simply means that you have an interest in the installation of the specified public improvement and that you will consider paying for the improvements through the formation of an LID. Petitioners are responsible for all costs associated with the preliminary investigation and feasibility study even if the LID is not formed. Once the petition is submitted, the District will prepare and submit to the property owners additional information for the project including cost data and LID procedures before scheduling a public hearing. Actual commitment of your property to the LID will come later through a public hearing process and a decision by the Board of Directors.
