

Signing simply means that you have an interest in the installation of the specified public improvement and that you will consider paying for the improvements through the formation of an LID. Petitioners are responsible for all costs associated with the preliminary investigation and feasibility study even if the LID is not formed. Once the petition is submitted, the District will prepare and submit to the property owners additional information for the project including cost data and LID procedures before scheduling a public hearing. Actual commitment of your property to the LID will come later through a public hearing process and a decision by the Board of Directors.
