Adopt and Implement Cross-Connection Control Policy

Elliot Lake Potable Water System

WHEREAS, the Kennewick Irrigation District Board of Directors has determined to create a Cross-Connection Control Policy for the Kennewick Irrigation District – Elliot Lake Potable Water System, hereinafter referred to as the “Water Purveyor”; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of Water Purveyor to provide water to the customer at the meter that meets Washington state water quality standards;


WHEREAS, it is the Water Purveyor's responsibility to prevent the contamination of the public water system from the source of supply (i.e., to the customer's connection to the service pipe or meter);

WHEREAS, it is a requirement of the Washington State Department of Health (DOH) for the Water Purveyor to establish a cross connection-control program satisfactory to DOH;


WHEREAS, cross-connections within the customer's plumbing system pose a potential source for the contamination of the public water supply system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors establishes Policy 6.1A “Cross-Connection Control Elliot Lake Potable Water System”, to be implemented as soon as practicable, to protect the purveyor-owned water system from the risk of contamination. For public health and safety, this policy shall apply equally to all new and existing customers.


