AUGUST 4, 2011 CANAL SEEPAGE REPAIRS

WHEREAS, technical compliance with the otherwise-applicable contracting procedures would reasonably delay the performance of public works necessary to address the above referenced emergency:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District confirms the Declaration of Emergency issued by the District Manager on August 4, 2011 and authorizes and ratifies the resulting actions of the District Manager in waiving competitive bidding practices and contracting for repairs.
