March 27, 2018 Main Canal 22.5 Mile Siphon Blockage

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, for the purpose of confirming the proclamation of the existence and nature of an emergency; and waive the competitive bidding process.


WHEREAS, the District Manager has reported to the Board that public interest or property of the District would suffer material injury or damage by delay; specifically that the canal was in imminent danger of overtopping and any delay could result in damage unless the siphon blockage was removed; and

WHEREAS, this constitutes an emergency and necessitates utilization of emergency powers, including but not limited to the emergency contracting authority granted pursuant to Kennewick Irrigation District Policy 2.13; and

WHEREAS, technical compliance with the otherwise-applicable contracting procedures would reasonably delay the performance of public works necessary to address the above referenced emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District confirms the Proclamation of Emergency issued by the District Manager on March 27, 2018 and authorizes and ratifies the resulting actions of the District Manager in waiving competitive bidding practices and contracting for repairs.




