**CONFIRMATION OF PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY AND
AUTHORIZATION TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS**

**April 24, 2019 for the purchase and installation of Ductile Iron Pipe and
associated appurtenances for PSA 117 pump station.**

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District, Benton County, Washington, for the purpose of confirming the proclamation of the existence and nature of an emergency; and waive the competitive bidding process.

WHEREAS, the District Manager has reported to the Board that public interest or property of the District would suffer material injury or damage by delay; specifically, that the existing steel pipe fractured requiring replacement of approximately 120 feet that includes beneath a city street and resulted in shutting off service to over 500 parcels within the city of Kennewick; and

WHEREAS, this constitutes an emergency and necessitates utilization of emergency powers, including but not limited to the emergency contracting authority granted pursuant to Kennewick Irrigation District Policy 2.13; and


WHEREAS, technical compliance with the otherwise-applicable contracting procedures would reasonably delay the performance of public works necessary to address the above referenced emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Kennewick Irrigation District confirms the Proclamation of Emergency issued by the District Manager on May 7, 2019 and authorizes and ratifies the resulting actions of the District Manager in waiving competitive bidding practices and contracting for repairs.
