NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Kennewick Irrigation District (KID) has issued a Determination of Non-significance under State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC).

Project Description: The proposal will improve KID's Willowbrook Pump Station to supply irrigation water to the new Clearwater Creek subdivision. Improvements include demolition of the existing pump station building, construction of a new and expanded pump station building, installation of pumps, pond suction lines, and siphon pipes, regrading of the existing irrigation pond and earthen access road, and installation of 8- and 12-inch pipelines to connect to the existing subdivision facilities.

After review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the agency, KID has determined that the proposed project will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.

Public Review: Interested parties may view the Determination of Non-significance and associated technical support documents, Monday through Thursday between 8:00 am and 5:30 pm at the KID administrative offices located at 2015 South Ely Street, Kennewick, WA 99337. Alternatively, the document and related materials may be viewed on the KID website at www.kid.org.

Comment Period: KID will not act upon this determination for a period of at least fourteen (14) days. The public is invited to comment on this Determination of Non-significance by submitting written comments to the address listed above. To be considered, all comments must be received by KID by the close of business on February 1, 2020.
