KENNEWICK IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2020-29

CLARIFICATION OF SURCHARGES IN SERVICE AREAS

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, for the purpose of clarifying surcharges for service connections in the Southridge and Clodfelter Master Plan Service Areas, and in other Service Areas.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 On April 5, 2016, the KID Board of Directors approved the Southridge Irrigation Master Plan, which established the Southridge Service Area, and the Equivalent Irrigation Unit (EIU) base surcharge at \$2,795.25 (Resolution 2016-14).

1.2 On September 6, 2016, the KID Board of Directors established surcharges for service connections in the Southridge Service Area (Resolution 2016-33).

1.3 On July 6, 2017, the KID Board of Directors approved the Clodfelter Irrigation Master Plan, which established the Clodfelter Service Area, and the Equivalent Irrigation Unit (EIU) base surcharge at \$2,741.19, and surcharges for service connections. (Resolution 2017-22).

1.4 Unique situations have arisen that have necessitated the clarification of transmission surcharges in the Southridge and Clodfelter Service Areas, as well as in other Service Areas.

Section 2. TRANSMISSION SURCHARGES.

2.1 A specific Service Area will be charged a Transmission Component Surcharge based on the KID Engineer Estimate for construction of the transmission infrastructure for that Service Area, for all properties that are not:

- 2.1.1 Currently serviced by a KID Pressurized Service Area (PSA);
- 2.1.2 Serviced by a single service connection from a KID mainline;
- 2.1.3 Located within either the Southridge or Clodfelter Master Plan Areas; or
- 2.1.4 Within an area for which transmission project(s) would be completed within the currently approved Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).

2.2 Each lot (a) within either the Southridge or Clodfelter Master Plan Service Areas and (b) existing at the time of adoption of the Master Plans is credited for one (1) transmission component EIU. Any lot receiving a new service connection, or upon subdivision requiring additional connections, shall be charged for any additional EIU(s).

Section 3. DISTRIBUTION SURCHARGES

For all properties referenced in Section 2, any distribution charges related to installation of new distribution infrastructure (e.g. in the case of PLA conversions) shall be a separate and distinct charge from the Service Area Transmission Component Surcharge or Master Plan Service Area EIU Surcharge.

Section 4. IMPLEMENTATION. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.

Section 5. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS. Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed. Nothing in this Resolution shall limit the future authority of KID to modify, rates charges and assessments.
