Financial Reports, October 2020: Mr. Drummond presented highlights of displayed report pages including:

Board of Equalization (RCW 87.03.255): Mr. Freeman reviewed the presentation of the 2021 Roll, legal notices and availability for review. He reported that no questions, comments, objections, or requests to review the roll had been received as of this morning.

<u>President Rathbun Vice moved to open the board of equalization. President McKenzie</u> seconded the motion. All present voted in favor and the motion carried.

President Rathbun asked the members of the public present if anyone wished to address the board regarding the board of equalization. Mr. McShane noted that microphones would be unmuted if anyone wished to speak, and that text comments would be monitored for the rest of the meeting. No person present requested to address the board.

President Rathbun said the board of equalization would be held open until the end of the meeting.

ACTION ITEMS:

PC2020-48 Amiad Filters & 16 Inch Pipe (Materials Only): Mr. McShane reviewed the purposes for the proposed purchases. The filters were for use at the Amon Pump Station in the Southridge Master plan area, and the pipe would be used at the Cherry Creek Pump Station in the Kennewick Southeast service area. He spoke about pricing, and said the pipe purchase would be paid from the Drought Fund and the filters and control panel would be paid from the Capital Upgrade and Improvement fund.

Discussion ensued. Mr. McShane spoke further about project benefits.

Director Ward moved to authorize the District Manager, Charles Freeman, to execute Contract PC2020-48: Amiad Filters and 16-inch Pipe (Materials Only) to the lowest responsible bidder, Core & Main, up to an amount not to exceed \$128,000.00. Director Huffman seconded the motion. All present voted in favor and the motion carried.
