2022 Authorized Positions and Salary Ranges, Revision 2

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Kennewick Irrigation District (KID), Benton County, Washington, relating to the establishment of authorized positions and salary ranges, authorizing and directing actions.

Section 1. RECITALS AND FINDINGS.

1.1 With the adoption of KID's 2021-2026 Six-Year Capital Improvement Plan, and due to KID's current and future projected workloads for the next several years, it is in the best interests of the District to make changes to the Authorized Positions and Salary Ranges for 2022. These changes are reflected in the attached spreadsheet entitled "2022 Authorized Positions and Salary Ranges, Rev 2".

Section 2. POSITIONS AND SALARY RANGES.

- 2.1 The following changes will be made to the Authorized Positions and Salary Ranges for 2022:
 - **2.1.1** Reduce the Operations Department by 1.0 position (from 42.0 to 41.0 positions).
 - 2.1.2 Reduce the total Number of FTE (Full Time Equivalent) employees by one from 99 to 98.
 - **2.1.3** Change the Assistant Operations Manager position title to Operations Manager.
- **Section 3**. **IMPLEMENTATION**. The KID District Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as appropriate and necessary to administer and enforce this Resolution.
- **Section 4. REPEALER; FUTURE ACTIONS.** Any KID act prior to and inconsistent with this Resolution is hereby superseded and repealed.
